- Dump trucks, water trucks
- Mixer (cement) trucks
- Large flatbed or two trucks
- Tandem axle straight trucks
- Garbage and front load trucks
- Luger or roll-off trucks
- Larger road-rail trucks
- Course Includes Air Brakes Endorsement

- 18 years of age
- Possess a valid Alberta driver's license with the **GDL removed**.
