This position will be under the direct supervision of the Safe Living Environment Program Coordinator and Health Director and shall maintain a direct working relationship with all applicable Western Cree Tribal Council and Canadian Mental Health Association Leadership.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Post-secondary level education (diploma/degree i.e., Social Work, Counselling, Psychology, etc.)
- Extensive experience facilitating partnerships with external organizations, health service providers, and First Nations partners supporting First Nation Members accessing mental health and addictions programming
- Must have a strong understanding of barriers associated with First Nations members accessing mental health and addictions services
- Ability to deal with the public in a positive, courteous, and respectful manner
- Follows policies and procedures of the organizations
- Ability to handle changing schedules and priorities, with high level prioritization skills
- Working knowledge of person-centered intensive case management practice including trauma informed care, addictions, harm reduction & recovery practice, and mental health first aid
- Ability to work independently or as part of a team
- Ability to act with discretion and maintain confidentiality
- Must have strong skills in writing, planning, organizing, and time management
- Knowledge of the Cree language and culture would be an asset
