The Casework Supervisor provides supervision of the day-to-day casework and program activities for staff within the Child, Youth & Family Enhancement Division with Western Cree Tribal Council, and deliver leadership, training, support, and direction to casework staff. Interested applicants should possess the following skills and qualifications:

- ✚ Proactive in supporting strong preventative and intervention programming to families in need and protection of children at risk.
- ✚ Provide regular formal supervision and ongoing case consultation. Monitor and evaluate the performance of casework staff and assist with caseloads.
- ✚ Excellent written and verbal communication skills. Develop and maintain collaborative working relationships and partnerships with key stakeholders and the team.
- ✚ Prioritize multiple projects and assignments through effective leadership, team building, critical thinking, decision-making, problem-solving, time management and organizational skills.
- ✚ Maturity and sensitivity to cultural and individual differences in clients, staff, and families served.
- ✚ Flexible schedule as this position requires participation in an on call/after hour's rotation schedule (evenings and weekends).
