Successful candidate responsibilities:

- Provides universal, targeted, and individualized supports and services to all students attending the Provincial schools in Hythe and Grimshaw.
- Provides consultative supports and services that promote academic and social inclusion.
- Supports and develops a strength-based model of services.
- Promotes mental health and wellness.
- Delivers specialized services that include sensory/self-regulation, visual perceptual skills, physical skills, organizational skills, and life skills.
- Promotes engagement and participation in literacy and numeracy by reducing barriers to learning.
- Delivers services to SSED students as well as students from K-12.
- Collaborates with the SLP and other members of the inclusive education team at each school.
- Delivers supports and services in the Division's geographic areas: Horse Lake School, Hythe Regional School, Beaverlodge High school, Grimshaw Public School, and Holy Family School Grimshaw
